THE CHRISTIAN WALK

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. (Romans 5:8-9 KJV)

God's love for us is so great that even while we were sinners he sent his Son to die for us, to die for our sins; and not only this, but he justifies us in the blood of his Son so that we can be saved.

Now that we have been justified and covered by the blood of Christ, how do we walk?

We walk in a new life. *Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.* (2 Corinthians 5:17 KJV) God is not interested in our past; he is not a God who is going to remember what we did in the past. Now that he has forgiven us, he has forgotten our past; in fact, he has buried it for ever. He is not like man, who many times forgives but when we commit another error, remembers our past. God is different. **God says that everything is new in us, a new way of life, a new state of being, a new way of speaking and even a new way of loving.** We are new husbands, new fathers, new sons. We have a new life in every aspect. We don't need to worry about the present or the future. God is our present and our future. I know many people who pay so that someone will predict their future for them. But those of us who are living a new life already know our future because the one who shows us what is to come is the Holy Spirit.

We walk with our head held high, with no reason to be ashamed of ourselves. *And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath.* ¹¹ *And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself.* ¹² *And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.* ¹³ *And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.* (Luke 13:10-13 KJV) Before Christ came into our life, we were bowed down like this woman. We couldn't walk upright because our sin prevented us from looking up into God's face. I am speaking spiritually. It's for this reason that we need not just to know about Jesus, but also to be born again in order to be able to walk upright and glorify God with our head held high. Now we walk with style, with God's style.

God says that everything is new in us, a new way of life, a new state of being, a new way of speaking and even a new way of loving.

We walk confidently. Not confident in our own strength; not placing our trust in good works or in man, but trusting completely in God. When we trust in the Lord, we place all our faith and hope in him. ⁵*Now He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who also has given us the Spirit as a guarantee.* ⁶*So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord.* ⁷*For we walk by faith, not by sight.* (2 Corinthians 5:5-7 NKJV). **We can blindly trust God, trust his promises, not hesitate even one moment in doing what he wants us to do.** Let me share something with you. My wife says that she likes everything about me, except for one thing. Do you know what it is? It is my patience. It doesn't matter how difficult the situation, I do not lose hope. Why? Because my confidence is in my God. Now she is learning the same patience, the same simple trust in the Lord.

I want to share some verses that speak of trusting in the Lord.

Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish in the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him. (Psalm 2:12 KJV)

And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, LORD, have not forsaken those who seek You. (Psalm 9:10 KJV)

Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him! (Psalm 34:8 KJV).

There are so many verses that show us the benefits of trusting in the Lord. I hope that you are walking confidently, hand in hand with God. Remember that apart from him we can do nothing. *I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. (John 15:5 KJV)*

When we seek first the kingdom of God without worrying about or focusing on the material, then and only then do we walk in blessing.

We walk in blessing. Something that we need to learn is that we must not be deceived as to what the blessing really means. Many believe that it is only something material or financial. Let me tell you that the blessing of God is something primarily and abundantly spiritual. The material is secondary. *But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. (Matthew 6:33 KJV).* **When we seek first the kingdom of God without worrying about or focusing on the material, then and only then do we walk in blessing.** The best thing that we can do is to seek the kingdom of God. We are truly spiritual when we give the honor and thanks to the Lord and not to ourselves. May God bless you.
